### INTRODUCTION

This is an Astro-Analysis based on the exact time, date, and place of birth calculated on the details supplied.

It is not intended to predict a budding mega-star or a future world leader - the objective is to provide some insights into the psyche of Drew to give everyone concerned a better chance of understanding, and hopefully helping this special child through the difficult growing times that they will face.

The astrological Chart is a little like a jigsaw puzzle without the benefit of a picture to follow. Some pieces are easy to recognize and they fit together beautifully. Another batch might fit well - but seem unrelated to the first "batch". Several straggly bits probably seem to belong to another world altogether, but that is the human psyche. The depths are immeasurable with many, many forms, faces, and dimensions.

Any Astrological chart will have seemingly several contradictions - again - just like human nature and our psychological make-up. But these apparent differences are all shades, shapes, and forms of the full picture. These "contradictions" should be seen as a balancing factor, knocking some of the edges off our sharp corners or, sharpening up the "softness" in the areas defined.

It should also be recognized that all of us have our own very personal lessons to learn in this life and these lessons unfold throughout the span of our entire life on earth. The learning experiences will not be systematic - they will be random episodes and experiences. Some interpretations of this Chart will give a glimpse of these very personal lessons that are an obvious part of this little one's character. Others may be so private or subtle that the child "learns" all by itself. And then there will be further lessons that will not have emerged or even seem significant yet.

It is hoped that the brief explanations throughout this analysis will help to explain the meanings and terminology of basic Astrology to give as much understanding as possible.

The two most valuable things that we can give to any child are our unconditional love and our time.

## Planets in Signs and Houses



### Gemini Ascendant

*The Ascendant is the exact degree in the zodiac, which was rising on the horizon at the time of birth. The term Ascendant and Rising sign are the same. Every 4 minutes the degree of the Ascendant changes. This is why it is so important to know the exact time of birth. This is the starting point of the astrological wheel and defines the signs on each house cusp in an anti-clockwise direction.*

*The actual houses and their meanings are just as important as the signs on the cusp.*

*The sign of the Ascendant is as important as the Sun sign, and its effects are often more obvious to other people. The Ascendant represents how the personality appears to others. Each sign has its own potential strengths, which should be developed, and weaknesses, which should be minimized through understanding.*

*Drew may run into problems if the rising sign is quite different in nature from the Sun sign. There will be conflict between an element of the inner self and the projected image. So, if any recurring social problems do occur, it is necessary to look within. The Ascendant in the chart is very important. It indicates the ways in which we interact with the world around us, the energies we put out, and the energies we receive from others.*

*Aspects to the Ascendant indicate what kinds of interaction we experience with others, the impressions we make on people, and the areas of our life that most involve other people. Often these aspects tell us about ourselves.*

Drew has the Ascendant or the Rising sign in Gemini. This is a bright sparkling personality - with plenty of wit and a very expressive nature. These kids love to be around people and have people around them. They are friendly, adaptable and good conversationalists. Drew will have quite special skills in all forms of communication. These kids are mentally alert. Whilst outwardly there is the show of heaps of confidence this often is not the case. These kids can actually be quite nervy and temperamental for seemingly little reason. Bear this in mind, and try to see beyond the surface of this entertaining child.

Drew will be happiest when doing new things. There will be real need to be involved with as many projects as possible. These kids just like being busy. But, like all kids, Drew will need plenty of rest. It can be a mission getting these kids to slow down, let alone stop! Story-time can be a good wind-down for them. But to keep from getting over-tired, Drew must be coaxed into having a nap and learning to switch off.

Gemini is the sign of the twins. The duality shows the personality as swinging from the friendly, fun-loving person to the moody temperamental person. One minute these kids will want to be the life and soul of the party and then the next minute will "switch off" completely. The attitudes will swing from hot and cold on opinions, ideas, and ideals without explanation. This is the hallmark of the Gemini personality. A Gemini ascendant can outwit, out smart and out talk most people. Drew will be great at debate, and interesting with it. Drew wants to cover every single topic there is. However, with this quick mind, Drew can learn a lot despite a lack of persistence.

These kids like to chatter. In fact, they may have difficulty keeping quiet even when they are supposed to. Instead of just sitting back and passively listening, Drew will want to be actively engaged. Sometimes this takes the form of a writing ability or a fondness for books. Anything that keeps the mind going will be attractive. Sometimes Gemini rising indicates ability in such fields as journalism, editing, communications or the mass media. It can also be an indication of considerable ability with the hands - or, perhaps, the more technical, scientific or mathematical area.

One of the virtues of this sign is that this child will never really grow old. They will always look younger than they are, which may be a bother when they are young, but they are bound to appreciate this when they do get older. Even more important, Drew will always be open to new ideas and experiences. This person will never grow old mentally either. They will want to be up with the play and current trends.

The Ruling planet in this Chart for Drew is Mercury - the ruler of Gemini. Pay careful attention to this chatty and intelligent little planet, as this will be a very strong part of the personality. The House in which Mercury falls will be an indication of where these great communicative abilities will be utilized.



### Sun in Pisces

*The Sun in the Chart is our personal light. It is our vitality, our creativity, and our basic ego. It is the Sun that provokes and promotes emotional security. The Sun represents our individuality. Within the Sun sign is our reason for being, our sense of pride, and our confidence. This is the basis of the search for the real person within. The sign occupied by the Sun at birth describes the nature of these basic drives and patterns. It describes the desire to be important to the people that matter and the ability to be independent and self-reliant. It will give us an indication of the methods used to develop psychologically.*

*The House will describe the areas of life that will be important and play a major role in our lives. It is here that we have the tools and the gifts to use as they were intended. But we may have to learn some vital lessons before this happens.*

*Much more is revealed by the aspects to the Sun. Positive aspects (trines, conjunctions or sextiles) are good indicators of self-reliance, confidence and the ability to stand on one's own two feet. The difficult aspects (squares, oppositions, and inconjunctions) will suggest psychological problems which can have a profound effect on life. However, learning to deal with these difficulties ultimately produces strength and understanding of the self. The rewards of working through these problems are great. The efforts will be*

*productive. Sure, work is needed, but it is worth the effort. However, whenever the planet, Saturn, brushes up against the Sun, it will suppress and depress the energy of the most exuberant Sun sign.*

*The Sun is the "self", the "life path", the "true" personality behind all the facades and defenses we all put up.*

*The child will start to grow into the Sun sign during adolescence which can be another reason why these years can be so dramatic and traumatic - this is just another set of growing pains that we all have to endure. The actual Sun sign is often not fully developed until nearer 30 years of age, but the inner spirit will emerge and glimpses will be seen throughout the growing years.*

Drew has the Sun in Pisces. The Pisces child is sensitive and idealistic. They are "tuned in" to the environment and aware of everything happening around them. They will pick up a bad atmosphere in an instant and literally "feel" any bad vibes or bad feelings. This is the "dreamer" of the Zodiac - creative, imaginative and often a bit mystical with many "friends" around them that only they can see. But some discipline is needed to keep these little dreamers on track. These kids need their space to collect their thoughts but must be drawn back into the real world if they go too far or for too long.

The Pisces child can be temperamental and emotional. In times of stress, they can close off completely. They are so very sensitive and very easily hurt but do need to be taught that a bit of reality is vital to their emotional well-being. These kids are usually rather shy and should not be forced into being what they are not. But make sure the shyness is not total insecurity and a total lack of confidence. Make these gentle kids feel good within and proud of just who they are. It is too easy for them to try too hard to please and so stifle their own personality. Try to make a big deal out of the natural generosity and kindness and help make Drew feel proud. The world needs these sensitive kids.

Drew will be kind, and loving but easily influenced by others and very easily led. There can be a difficulty being able to say, "No." These kids are often as fond of animals as they are of the human race. They just love to "care" and to "take care of", but these little people need lots of love and encouragement back as well. They may need to learn to accept the love and warmth that they are so fond of giving. The true Piscean character can slip into the role of the self-imposed martyr which would be a great waste of the sensitivity that is here.

These kids can be very artistic and creative with such a powerful imagination. It would be a shame not to nurture these talents which might not always be obvious. The Pisces child will seldom demand anything - even attention.

If there are lots of planets in the sign before or after Pisces (Aries or Aquarius), this little one will be a lot tougher and far more out-going.

### Sun in the Tenth House

*10th House: This House points to the dominant parent. That parent's attitude, expectations, and ambitions for the child are reflected here. Here is an indication of how the child deals with responsibility and with authority. An ambition to "be someone" or to be recognized in this life is associated with the powerful 10th House. The sweet smell and taste for power and success emerges from this very zenith of the natal chart.*

The Sun in the Tenth House is powerful, no matter what. Success will come if the right training or direction is given. Drew will have some big ideas and will work very well independently. It is likely that there could be difficulty actually working with others as this little character will have its own ideas, not being especially interested in listening to anyone else. This person wants to get somewhere, has ambition, and wants to be in control of their own fate.

However as a child, this ambition and determination can cause a few problems. These kids are pretty pumped up and can clash quite badly with those in authority. They will question and talk back knowing that simply accepting everything is not opening up the brain enough. Teachers and the likes may not see it that way. It can be taken as a seeming lack of respect, so discipline in learning to "button up" at times will make life easier for Drew in the long run.

The Sun in the Tenth House points to a powerful relationship with the Father (or authoritative person). This particular figure can teach Drew so much. If it happens that the natural father is not around, another adult will be important in a fatherly way and will be a great influence. But whoever, there will be arguments from time to time. This child will disagree and try to rebel. But the mutual respect will be very important and it will be there, although the "Father" could question that at times.

Initially, this child can perhaps leap into the wrong career, but it will be experience and nothing will be lost. The Tenth House Sun often suggests fame and honor or sometimes scandal. No matter, this position is one that suggests Drew will be noticed. With maturity, the ambition and the determination will win respect. It could be on a small scale, perhaps just on the local scene, but this child will lead by example and be quite inspirational. Few with this elevated Sun remain obscure.



## **Moon in Cancer**

*The Moon is our instinctive, emotional response. It is the innermost feelings and sensitivities that stem from the subconscious. Our Moon will always be our natural reaction when our defenses are down. The Moon reflects our early conditioning, our habits, and the automatic responses that come from our early environment. Often all of this relates directly to the "Mother" figure. It is perhaps the "child" in all of us. In reading a child's chart, the Moon, in the house, the sign and the aspects, needs to be given special understanding. These are the indications on where Drew could need special attention very early, to cope with feelings of insecurity, lack of confidence, or a low self-esteem. Recognizing these needs, and working through them, will help to produce a secure and confident adult.*

*The Moon often reflects the "Mother figure" in our lives, which is consequently why the Moon figures so strongly in a child's chart. The placement of the Moon often describes the relationship with the Mother, which is why the "Mother" is mentioned in many areas of the Moon explanations.*

*The Moon sign is the more noticeable personality trait in the formative years. We tend to "grow into our Sun sign as we develop and become the person we were meant to be. The Moon in the Chart signifies the unconscious attitudes and feelings and whether or not we feel supported and accepted. It is also the accumulated attitude reflected by our own past and the historical past. The Moon will echo values and instincts that are picked up from our early environmental experiences.*

*This luminary is the most important factor after the influences of the Sun and the Ascendant. It describes how we express our emotions and how well we deal with them.*

*In some cases, the ever-important Sun can put up some defenses against the Moon. When very different, we can struggle to assimilate our emotions and our reason. Like the other planets, the Moon has strong and weak points in any sign, and we should try to develop the strong points. If the Moon is in compatible company, we will express our emotions very easily and we will be sensitive to other people's needs and feelings. With competition, the Moon can mean that there can be difficulty letting our feelings flow. The Moon and the Ascendant can be of an awkward mix, making the projected personality, and how we actually feel inside, quite different. But, this is all a part of the character and we are well able to bind the differences and round off the disposition.*

*The Moon and the emotional problems it produces can sound negative but this is not so. This is a beautiful and fundamental part of our deepest psyche that we must all*

*accept and use to its fullest advantage.*

Drew has the Moon in the sign of Cancer, so this is very much a "Moon child". This is the natural sign for the Moon. These kids are very sensitive and very emotional. They pick up all sorts of vibes and, unfortunately, more than readily take the blame for any discord. They naturally think that if anything goes wrong, it was "their fault". It is most important that this little one be reassured. They have to be taught that they do not have to carry the burdens of the world on their shoulders. These children are very loving and affectionate with strong nurturing and protective instincts. They will probably start bringing home waifs and strays quite early because they love to protect those that they think have a raw deal. This little one will probably love to play "house", grabbing the role of Mother or Father, and will have their own views of how they think the "house" should be run too. Having friends play at their house is very important to these kids because they love their home more than most and like to show off their own environment. There is the reassurance that nothing will change in their absence too. You may notice that Drew is a good mimic, especially when it comes to sounds. These kids will "copy" how their favorite people do things too.

This little one can throw a sulk like no one else, and can keep it up for just as long as they like. ### **Moon in the Second House**

*2nd House: This House is about values and possessions. It is the "my things" attitude. It is where nourishment is needed to feel confident and secure. This House is about experiencing the sensual fundamentals in order to feel fulfilled and loved. This House puts a real value on tangible assets and it is where real fears are born with respect to deprivation. It is also where we learn to provide for ourselves if we must. It is where we discover our "comfort zone".*

With the Moon in the second house, Drew badly needs to learn to feel emotionally secure. These kids will tend to gauge how good they feel by personal possessions. The more "things" that they own, the greater the sense of security, so consequently they tend to have difficulty parting with anything. Drew will almost get emotionally involved with personal possessions. If these children are not guided into understanding and accepting that real security comes from within, they can become very selfish. These kids need to know that they are loved anyway, for themselves, not for what they own. This lesson will be valuable for Drew in adulthood because, if the theory becomes stuck that "money maketh" the man, there will be a struggle in the areas of finance. This little character could become the classic shop-aholic. Or, these types can go swinging from frugal to fanciful, and create their deepest fears - poverty. Underneath, these people do have good sound sense in financial matters. They can make wise decisions. They can juggle the budget very well, but they must look outside of the monetary values for self-confidence.

Similar lessons are needed within friendships too, as Drew can be too possessive. Let this little one see that even if they give friends some breathing space - those friends will come back - because they want to. Drew does have to learn that ownership is not related to personal security.

These kids will learn to be especially shrewd and acquisitive because the emotional comfort, in general, is dependent on material comfort. *The little planet Mercury is the mythical Messenger of the Gods. This planet is never far away from the Sun, often falling in the same sign at the time of birth, so it does tend to*

*add emphasis to our Sun Sign. Even when Mercury is in the sign before or after the Sun, this is always considered a very personal planet.*

*Through Mercury, we learn all the basics in life. It indicates how we communicate, because it is here where we begin to watch and copy the rest of the family. This is the very beginning of questions and curiosity that fires up and fuels the learning process. From that point, we move on to recognizing the senses, and so our personal tastes and style develops. We learn how to exchange ideas and show how clever we are. We start to question and analyze. We learn to reason and classify what we have absorbed and then stretch for more information.*

*Mercury is our first experience of moving out into the world beyond the back yard, armed with all that we have learned. Through this planet, our flexibility and dexterity is revealed. This planet covers the intellectual stimuli but it also has a say in how clever we are with our hands and how well balanced we are physically.*

*Mercury is also associated with the nervous system. This is a busy little planet at the best of times, and responsible for a big part of our intrinsic character. When put under too much pressure, the nervous system buckles. Mercury is indicative of our sense of humor, the body language we exude, and our powers of expression. This is the planet of logic and reason. So, Mercury is indeed a very important planet. It might be tiny, but it is very potent.*

Drew has the Planet Mercury in the sign of Aquarius. These children are quick thinkers, their ideas are original, but they are stubborn. They come up with some unique thoughts but once a notion or opinion is fixed in their mind, they hold on to it adamantly. Their mind is clever, detached, and abstract, and often ideas seem to come through as bursts of insights rather than through careful calculations. These kids do like to air their views, and will gladly spend all the time in the world explaining the basis of these complicated theories.

It is about expanding on what today offers and taking it into the future.*

This child with Mercury in the 9th House will have a fascination with the big wide world. There will be a natural interest for all the different people, different cultures, and different places. These children simply "think big." Because of this, Drew will be a keen student with a natural love of learning. There will be a curiosity and inquisitiveness in a variety of subjects.

However, these youngsters can be quite selective in where they place their energy. They throw themselves in whole-heartedly when they are interested, but get very bored and disruptive if they are forced into applying themselves to a topic that they do not like. Often the scientific subjects will appeal more than the creative, or abstract arts during childhood, but with maturity, their interests will have no boundaries.

Drew will learn to be very proud of all the knowledge that has been gained and will like nothing better than passing on and sharing these experiences of learning. Mercury in this house indicates special teaching ability because there will be such a colorful and expressive approach that others want to listen to.

*Venus is important because it shows how youngsters interact. It is where children learn to share and give. Venus shows how Drew attracts love and attention and also what and who Drew is attracted to. This planet will indicate whether the basic nature is warm and affectionate or whether there is some reserve attached.*

*Venus is also about our creature comforts and possessions - what we need in life to feel good. Venus indicates our creativity and artistic talents and the ability to appreciate beauty. Good, bad, or unusual taste will be seen through Venus.*

*The house that Venus is in indicates the area in which artistic talent is expressed. This is where the expressions of sensual understanding will be valid and utilized. It can also suggest where Drew may need special attention and nourishment, in order to learn how to interact with others.*

*For future reference, Venus in the signs, houses and aspects will be quite revealing about relationships with the opposite sex and matters of the heart.*

With Venus, the planet of love and comfort, in the sensitive sign of Pisces, Drew will be a quiet, almost mystical child. These children are drawn to pretty colors and shapes - the clouds, the sky and the Moon will fascinate. The burning fire in the hearth will conjure up all sorts of pictures for Drew. The likes of the wind whistling and the rain falling will be music to this deep and sensitive child. There will be a love of glossy books with pretty pictures. With this aspect, this child should be allowed to study what they want. This minimizes wasted time and avoids unnecessary rebukes. This child will probably know best anyway, and important choices will be quite correct. But this can be difficult for those in authority to accept initially. Force will never gain a whole lot of ground, and anyway, Drew does have a sound and solid understanding on personal issues. As this little one develops, learn to listen and to trust the sound judgement that will be voiced.

This aspect is often in the charts of investigators, detectives, and those involved in research. The understanding of human nature is profound. There is a natural and easy understanding of logic, and of cause and effect, which can help in studying psychology

### **Mercury sextile Neptune (Strength: 3.49)**

With the expressive planet Mercury inconjunct Saturn, the planet of limitations, Drew can suffer from hidden fears that are difficult to express. These fears may seem to have no beginning or substance, but this child can still be afraid. These little ones could have

### **Uranus trine Midheaven (Strength: 1.99)**

*Trines bring ease, harmony, and success, which need little effort. Can help creativity.*

Drew has the planet Uranus trine the Midheaven. Probably from a very early age, this child will have beliefs and ideas that are different from most other people around them. They may not be in the slightest bit interested in possessions of any sort. Later in life, possessions to these people become like chains to them. They prefer to be free and unencumbered. Even in the tender years, Drew can seem to decide there is a path to follow that is unique. Consequently, these children can pay little attention to what adults think that they should do. They march to their own drum, but they seldom offend.

When these children are a part of a close or tight family environment, they may feel smothered. But when they are free to do what they want, they feel alone, and even neglected. But Drew needs both - a lot of loving support, and a lot of freedom to move about and be an individual. The nature can be irritable, irrational, and at times, lethargic. Maybe check out the diet. It is possible that some foods can have an adverse effect and Drew is actually suffering a physical problem caused by this that can be addressed.

### **Saturn square Pluto (Strength: 1.47)**

*The Squares are quite subjective. Squares bring challenges that must be worked through.*

Drew has Saturn square the very slow moving planet Pluto. Both of these planets move slowly, especially Pluto, so all of the kids in the same age group as Drew will feel the effects. Unless either of these planets make a close connection to the Ascendant, the Midheaven, or one or more of the personal planets this aspect should be regarded as relatively minor.

### **Sun conjunct Midheaven (Strength: 0.83)**

*The conjunction adds emphasis to the power, the energy, and the vitality of the planets involved by the close proximity.*

Drew has the Sun in conjunction to the MC. Even while young, ambition to get somewhere in life will be strong. Drew will have dreams of being rich and famous. Self-consciousness can hamper this very outcome. These kids tend to measure their success in life not so much by values, but by the impact they can make. They simply like to impress others and seem to need approval from others for what they do. They work to create a particular image. And yet, these kids can make life hard for themselves because they are very independent. They do not like buckling down under anyone. This can create problems while they are young. They seem to think that they know better

### Venus conjunct Jupiter (Strength: 0.00)

Maybe Drew needs to be taught that life is never served up on a silver platter - someone had to put in some serious work somewhere along the line to reach this particular lifestyle.

Later in life, Drew will be rather self indulgent, and be too fond of high living. Jupiter expands all that it touches and the lovely planet Venus is all good stuff. But, this larger than life character, the generous nature, and sincere disposition, are all mostly highly positive. Love, harmony and a strong sense of beauty produce few negatives. Learning to apply a little more energy and not be so complacent can only help to enlarge the good of this aspect.

## Balance of Elements and Modalities

### Abundant Water

*The water signs are Cancer, Scorpio, and Pisces. Water indicates sensitivity, compassion, and imagination. These kids can be very deep and private. They can seem to be quite shy. A dominant moon, Neptune, or Pluto can add to the abundance of water characteristics in this chart.*

These children are the most sensitive and emotional of all. They often feel not only their own emotions but also those of the people around them. When a water person meets someone for the first time, they can often size up the depths very quickly and accurately through sheer intuition. It is very important that the parents handle this ability carefully. They will need to be wary about who these children associate with. These kids can pick up negative and bad vibes as easily as they can pick up good vibes. And when they do hone into negative vibrations, they will take the whole lot on board themselves. "Other peoples problems" will become part of this sensitive child. For this same reason, it is not necessary to reprimand water children harshly. They get the picture with very few words and will "feel" the rest. In fact, it is less important to reprimand water children when they have done wrong than it is to reassure them afterward. ### Lack of Earth

A lack of the Earth element in this chart suggests that this child may have some difficulties dealing with practical and mundane issues. In fact, it may be said that they are not really at home on the planet Earth. Drew may seem to be somehow lost in space and unable to get the feet on the ground. Because of this, these kids may reject responsibility. They can have trouble getting organized and following through on a task. Often there can be a childish inability to handle boring, but necessary tasks. Drew could be one of those kids who need help to accomplish the simplest chore. Material matters and money may be secondary concerns. These types may not be particularly interested in earthly possessions or any sort of material gain. More often, the absence of earth signs means good old-fashioned common sense may not be a strong suit. Drew should be encouraged to spend time outdoors with nature, to get in touch with the basic practicalities of life, and to learn to be more accountable and to take responsibility.

### Lack of Fire

When the Fire element is lacking, it may benefit this child to become more active and more urgent. They may lack the passion and spark that the fire signs give. This does

not mean that Drew will not enjoy life, but merely that there is a reluctance to burst into action. In some cases, a child lacking fire in the chart may try to force many of the more aggressive fire sign traits in order to compensate for the actual lack of these traits. Characteristic of this would be a person who excels at a sport (perhaps) finding the ability to win through extreme hard work and dogged perseverance. The fire, in this case, is lacking but the "burning" comes from within.

### **Abundant Mutable**

*The mutable signs are Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius, and Pisces. These are the signs of change, and the essential mark is adaptability.*

Drew will either try to find a way around a problem or will give way in the face of the attack. This quality of mutability is not a weakness, because although these kids do bend like a reed in the wind, they do manage to survive and persist. Drew will believe in flowing with the energies of the surrounding environment. These kids can adapt to the characteristics of the current company. Nevertheless, these children have a core of inner truth that enables them to make quite a subtle impact on those around them. By appearing to give way, these kids can sometimes be quite manipulative.

The mutable signs except Virgo are known as dual or two-bodied signs (meaning that they have two distinct sides). This reflects the mutable person's ability to have more than one facet. Drew will actually thrive in unstable and changing circumstances. These kids are able to grab what they need and adapt very quickly to new conditions. In fact, often boredom will set in if the situation is not constantly changing. With all of this adaptability, however, Drew can be rather devious at times. ### **Abundant Cardinal**

These are the self-starters - the self-imposed leaders. For this reason, it is sometimes difficult for cardinal-sign people to co-operate and compromise easily. Libra is a bit of an exception being so "agreeable" in many aspects of life, and being so willing to please. But the strong Libran will often take the initiative in starting a friendship. It is in this area that these particular (Libran) people will take the initiative. Unfortunately, the Cardinal signs may not finish what they have started.

Drew will enjoy the role of the leader, but may not take it very well if forced to take a secondary role. If these kids are not calling the shots, they may well lose interest altogether. It can be easier for them to avoid group activities rather than take the more submissive role of watching someone else run the show.
